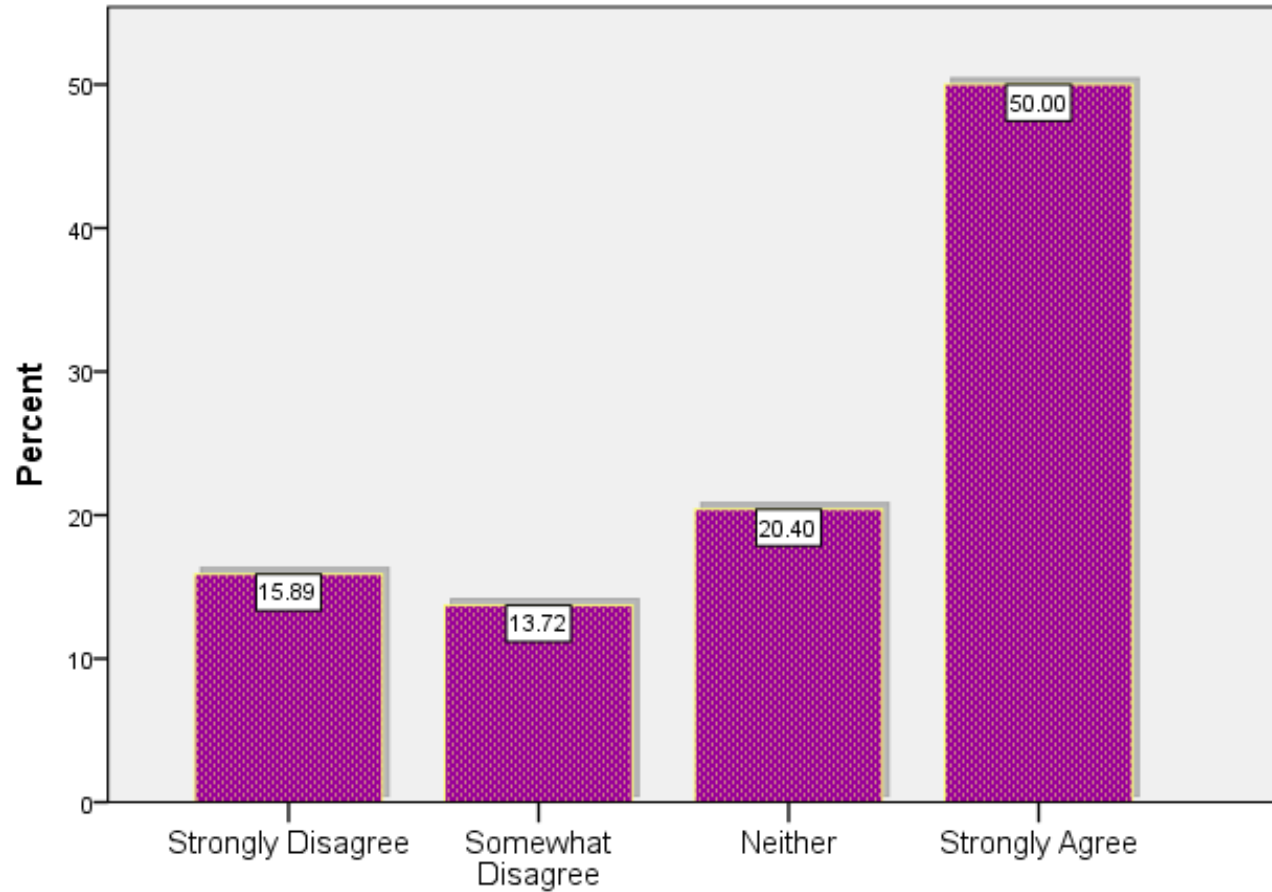

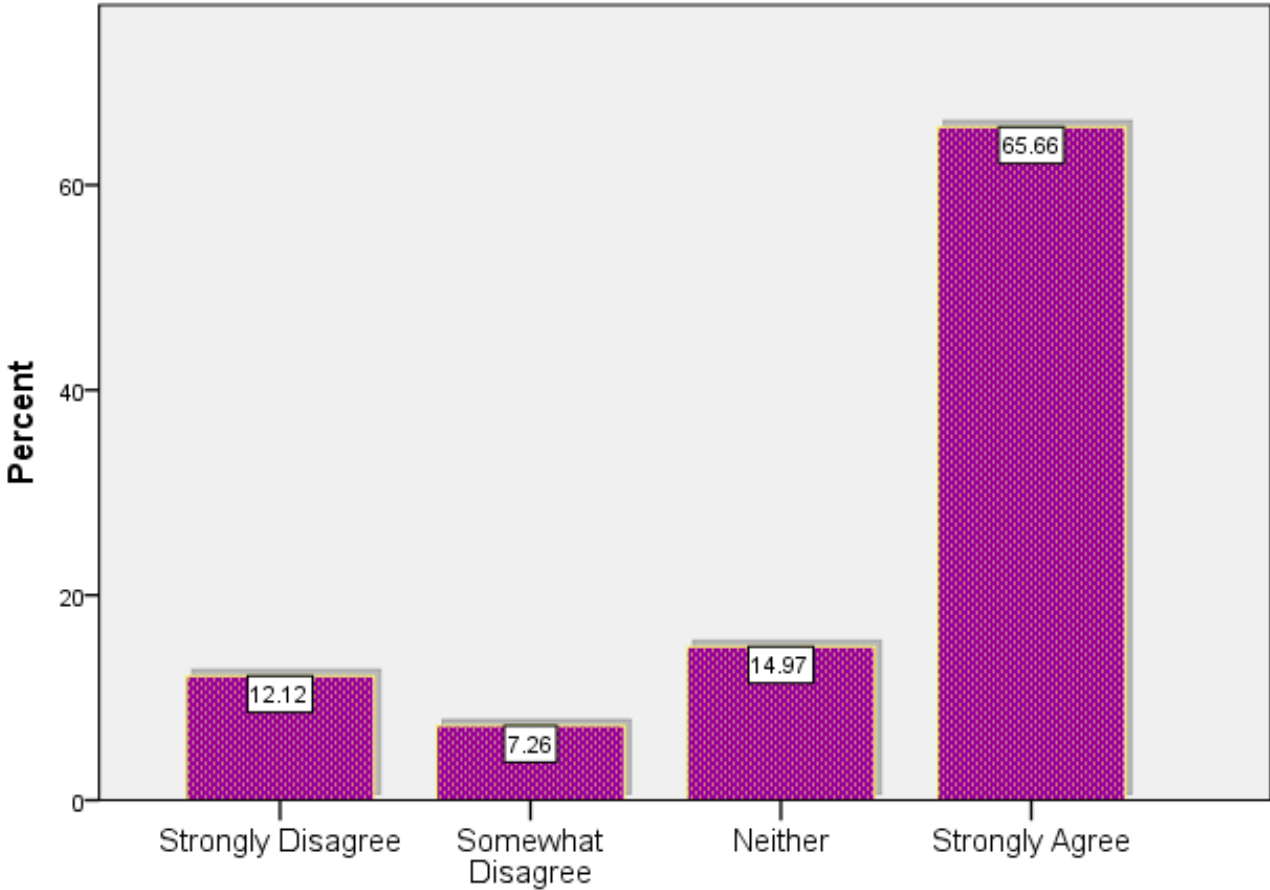
MEMBERSHIP

1. Clubs should be limited to only Kings Point residents



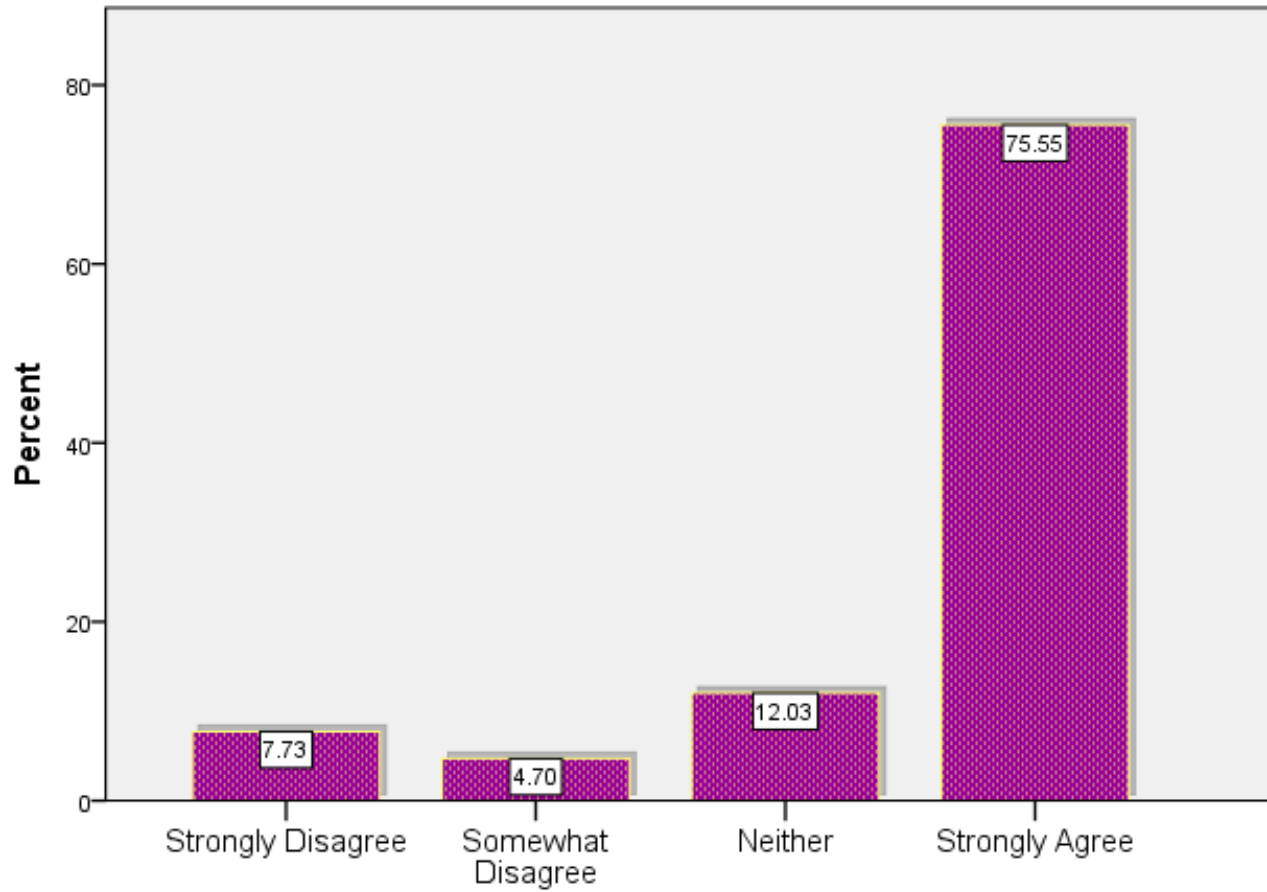
NONRESIDENTS

2. Clubs should be able to determine how many members are not KP residents



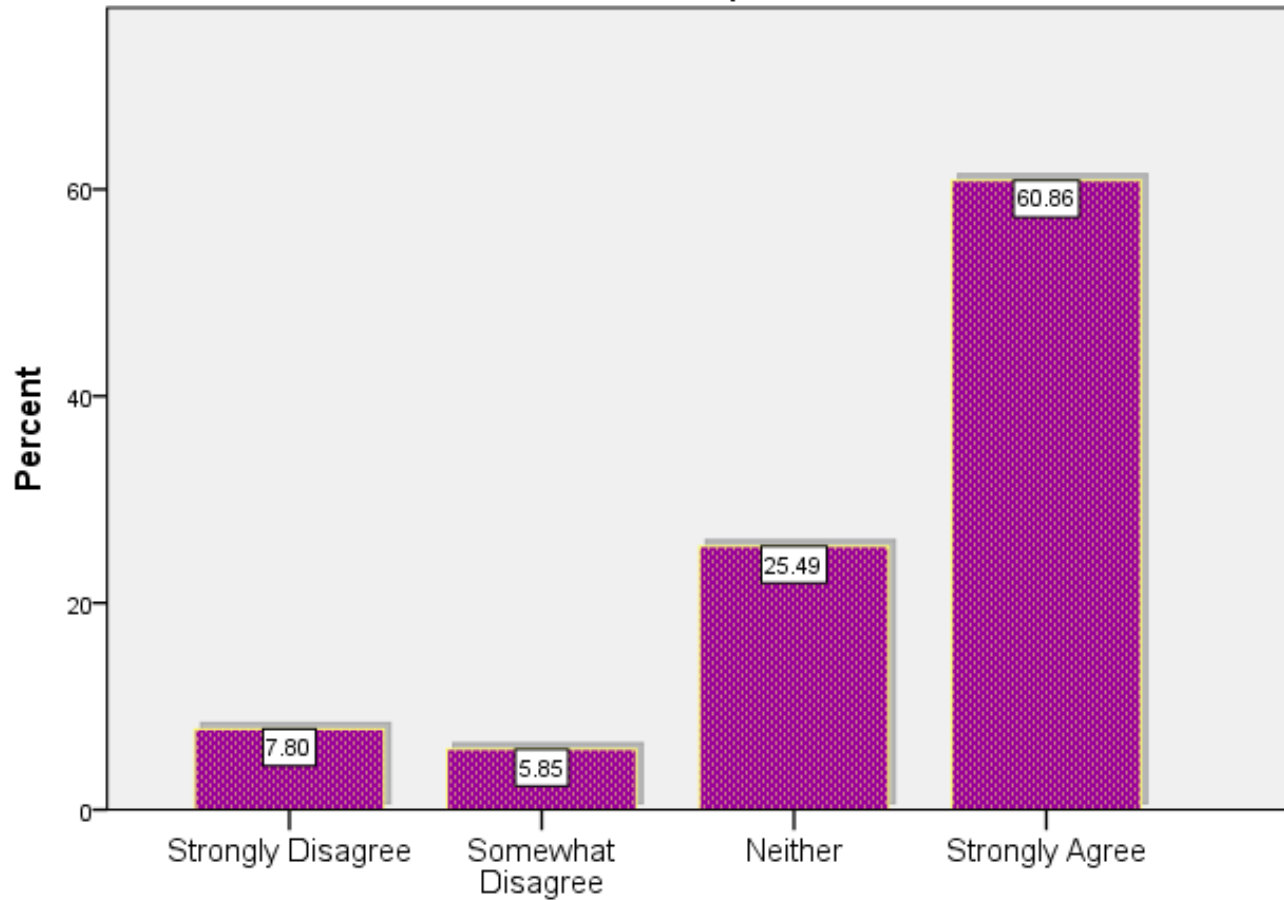
NONRESIDENT FEES

3. Non-residents should pay additional fees to cover the use of club facilities



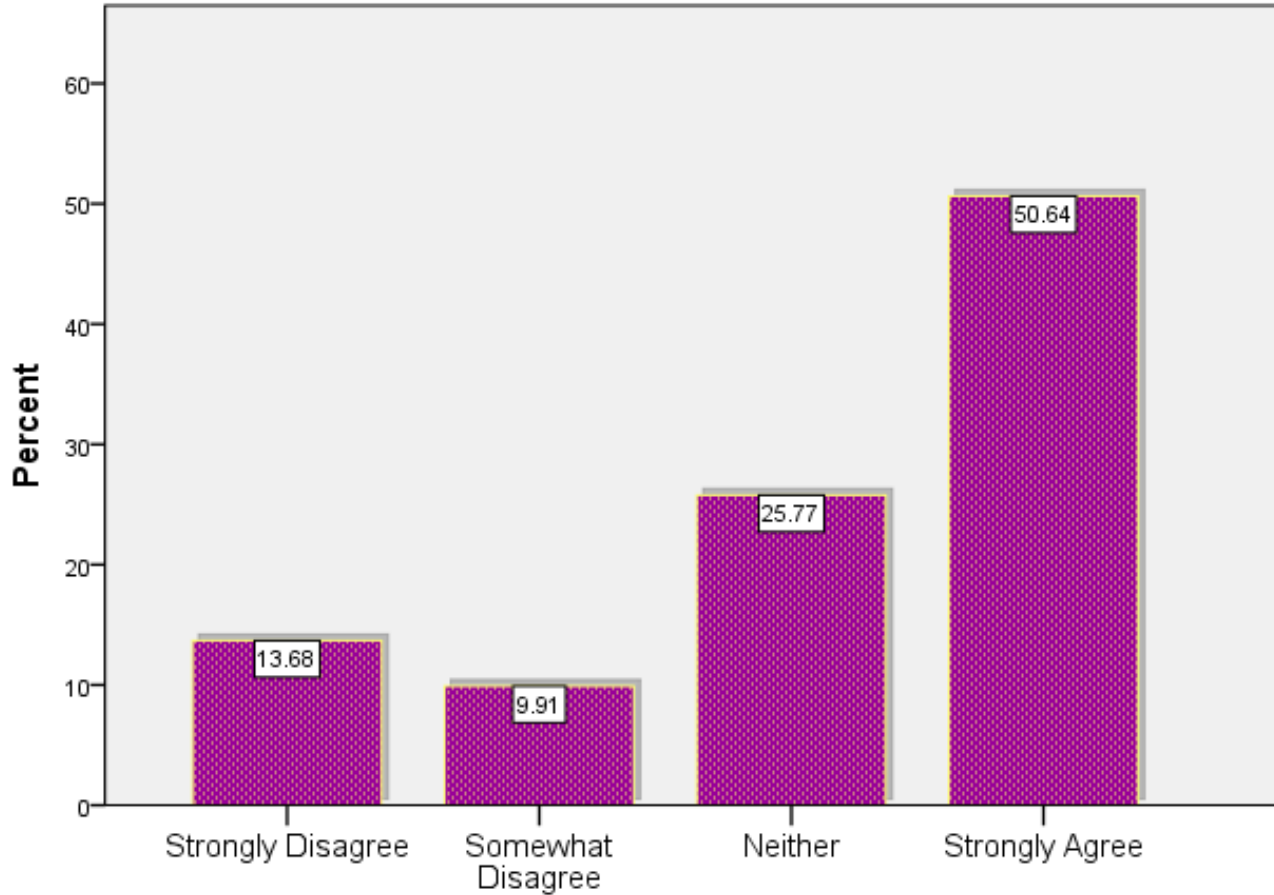
RESERVE BY SIZE

4. Space in clubhouses should be reserved according to the number of attendees at an event instead size of club membership



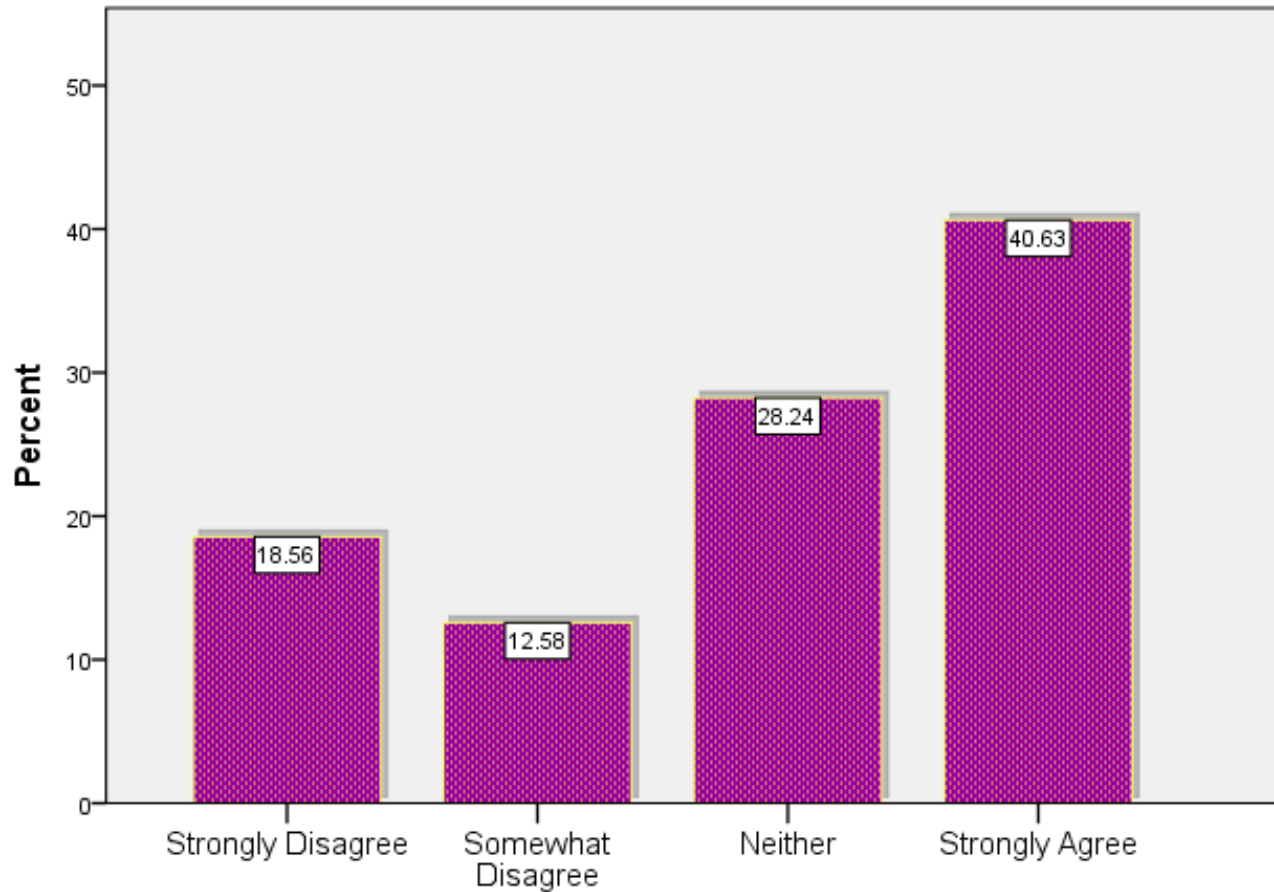
SHARED SPACE

5. Clubs should share space instead of having exclusive use of a space



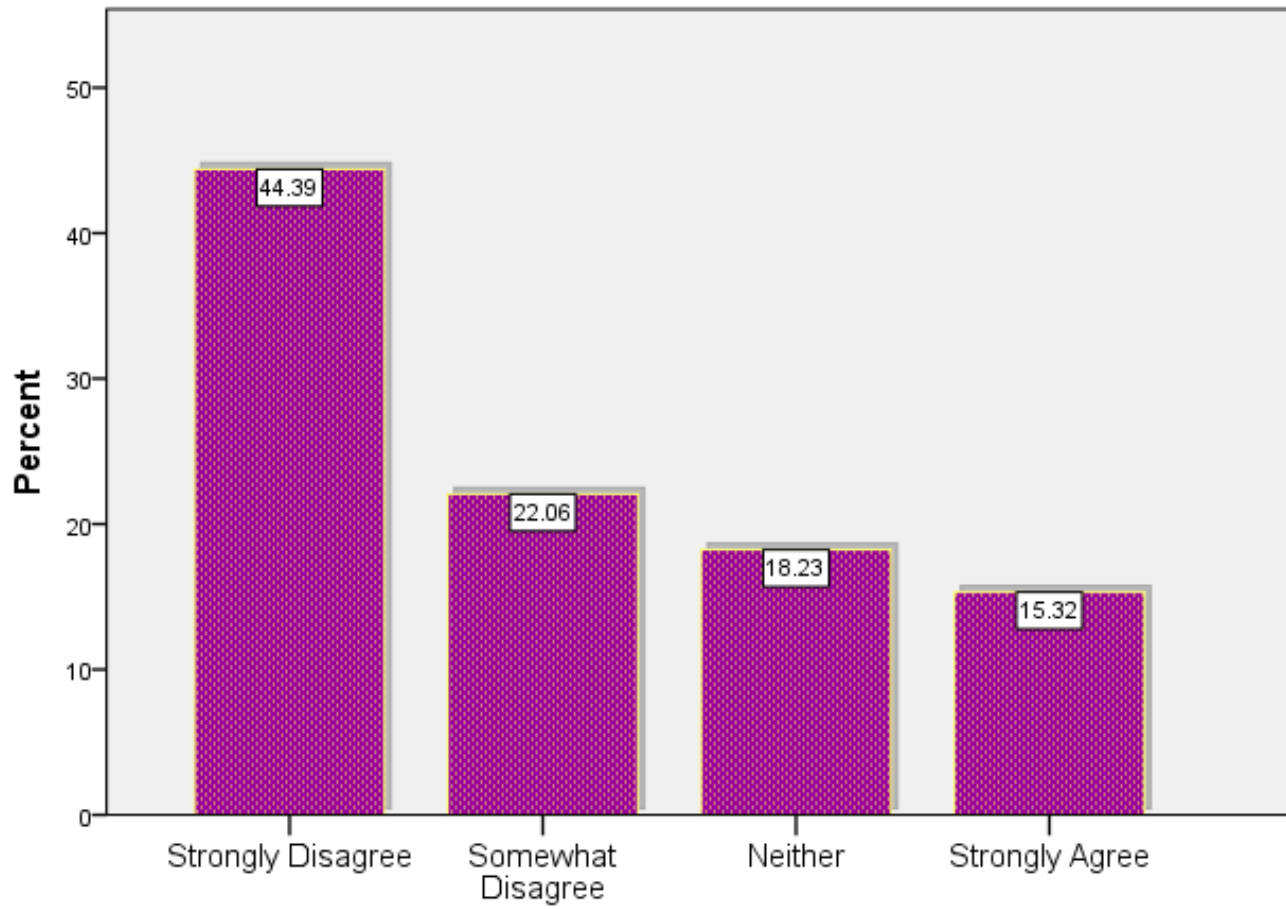
PRIORITIES

6. Clubhouse room reservations should be prioritized according to the type of specialty activity taking place in the room



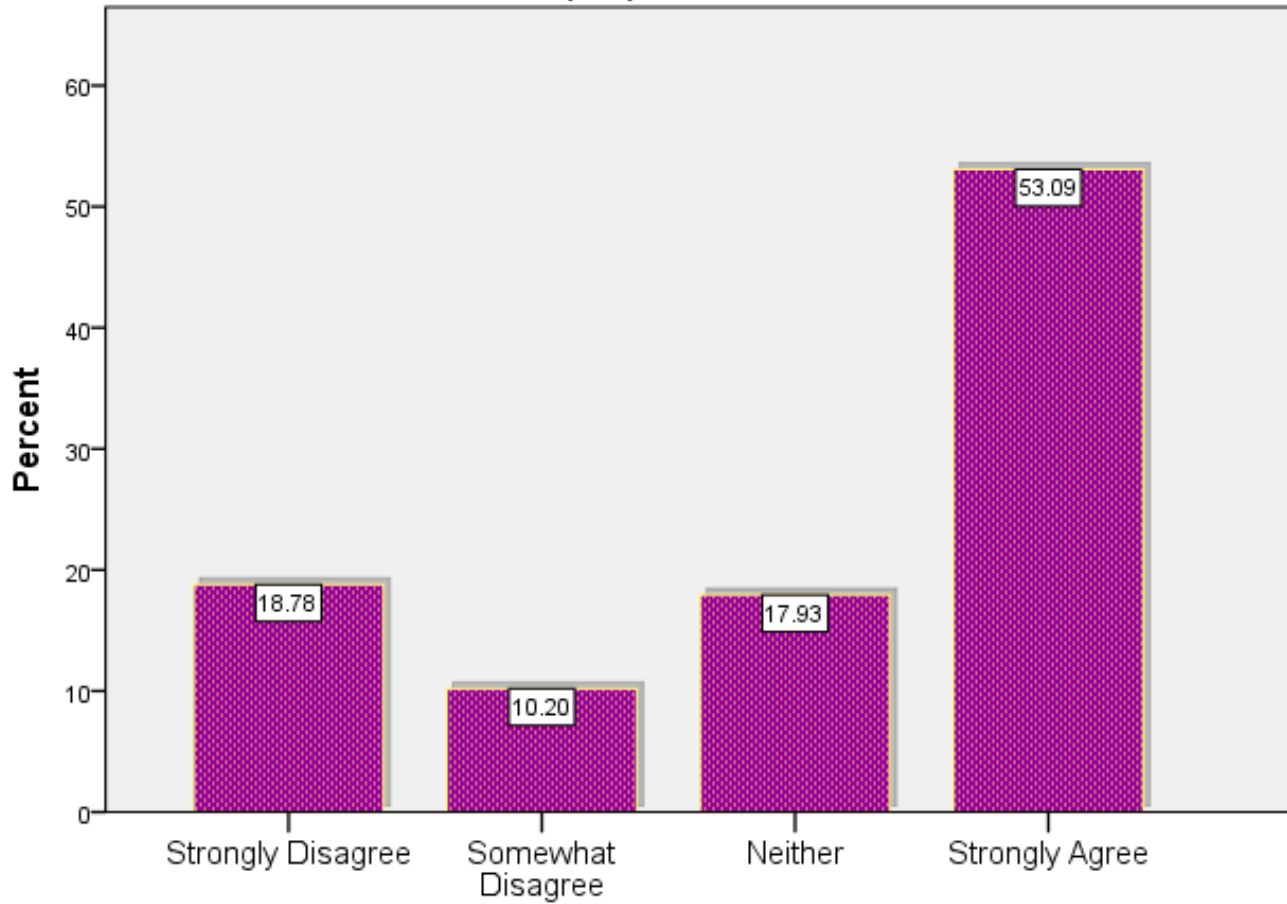
RESERVED PARKING

7. Clubs should be able to reserve parking for club activities



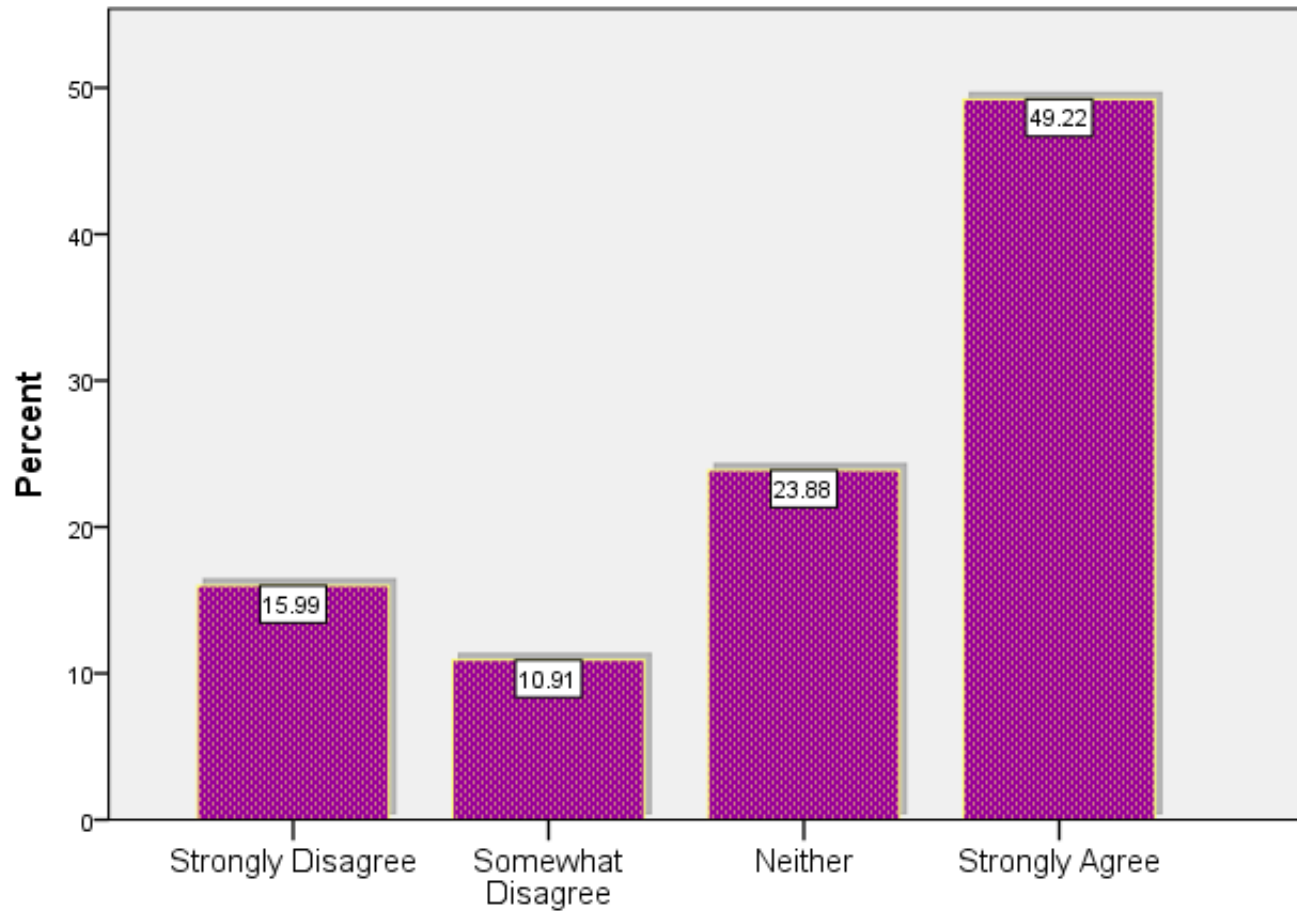
INSTRUCTORS

8. If an instructor makes money from classes taught using KP facilities, a portion of that profit should go toward the upkeep of the KP facilities



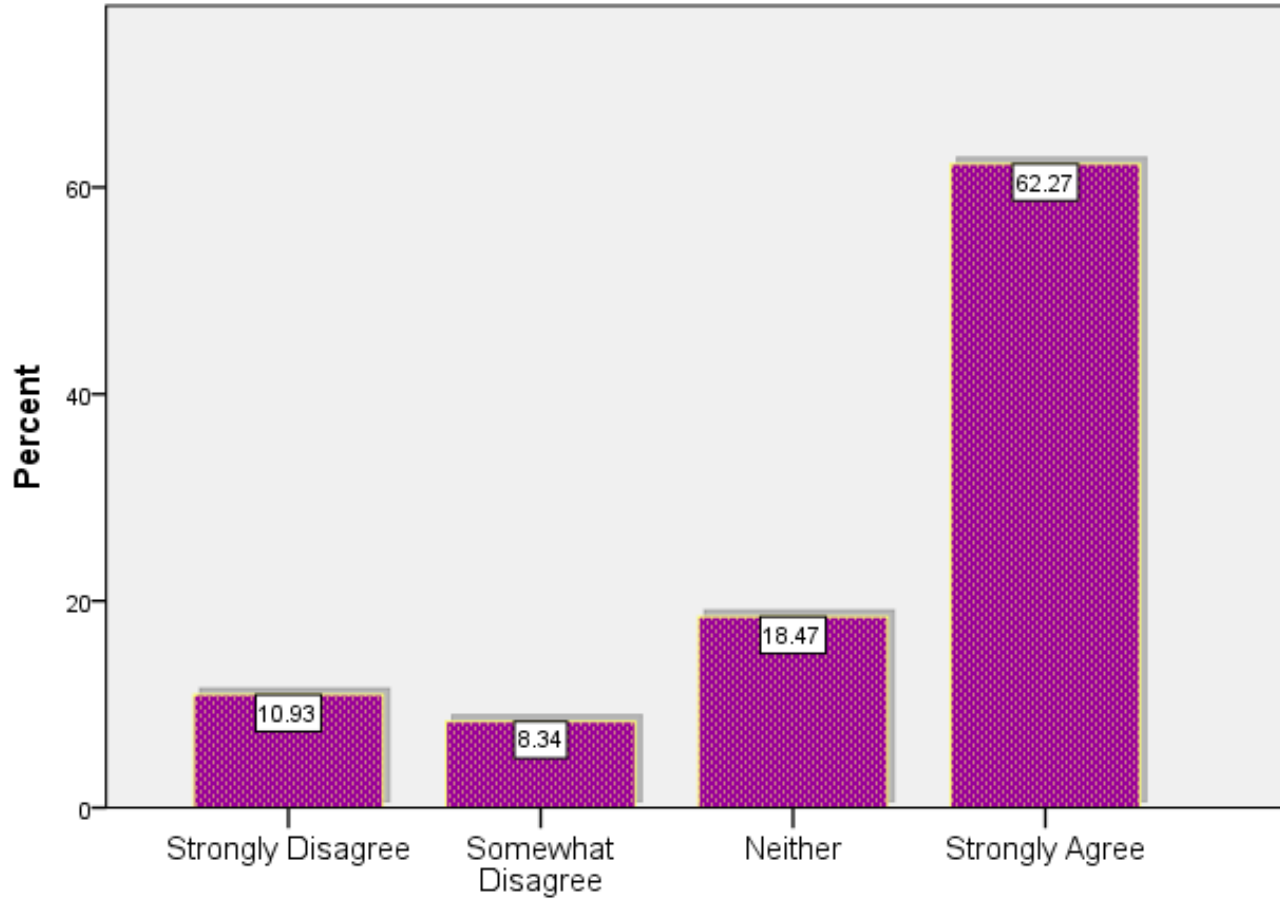
ADVANCE RESERVATIONS

9. All clubhouse rooms should be reserved 90 days in advance instead of in perpetuity



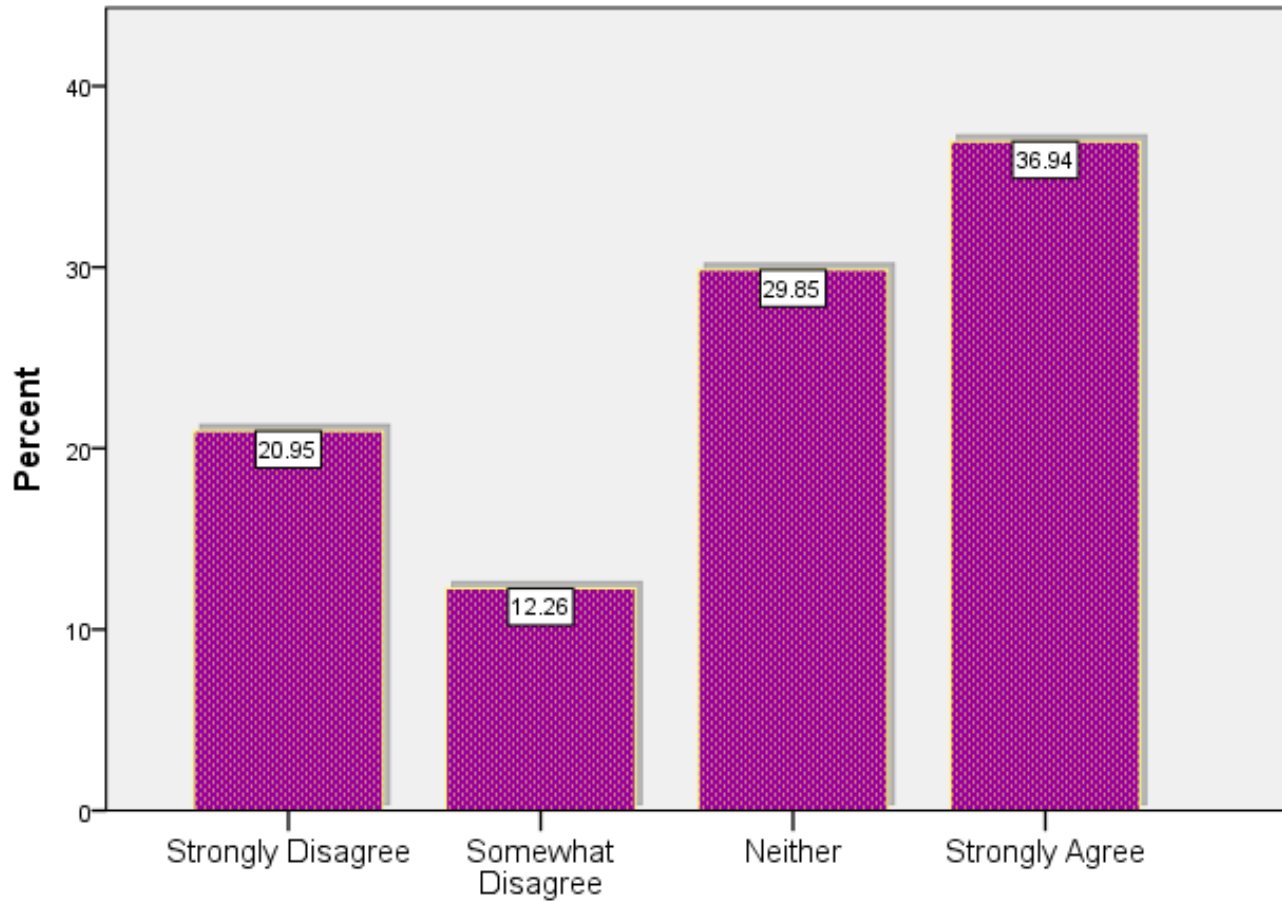
SPECIAL EQUIPMENT
